



"The Hidden Man Revealed"

I Cor 2:14

No matter how smart a natural man is he can't understand the things of God because they are spiritually discerned.

The first thing that happens to the man that becomes a new creature is that his spirit becomes alive to the things of God.

A man of the soul does not welcome the things of the spirit because they have to be spiritually examined. The man with spiritual insight can understand everything although he himself is understood by nobody.

The spirit works best when the head is at rest.

The spiritual man judges all things.

I Cor.2:14

When Paul talks about judgement here he is talking about supernatural perception.

Paul says he compares spiritual things with spiritual.

The unspiritual man can not take in the things of God. Spiritual things are only understood by the spiritual part of man.

If you are really a spirit, you are really not a great man until the spirit is developed.

Spirit beings are eternal but they can either have the nature of God or the nature of Satan.

The only time a man really walks right is when he is walking in God because he was designed to walk with Him.

Even the believer who doesn't continue to walk around with God is a mess.

I Thess. 5:23

God wants our whole being kept sound.

The spirit is the unseen self that relates to God.

I Peter 3:4

The spirit of man is the hidden man.

II Cor.5:1-6

Paul says that when the body is taken off you get down to the real you.

Taking off the body is like taking off a coat.

It's easy to see that the unseen man is the real man.

No one has ever seen a body walking around without a spirit.

We have records in the bible about spirits without bodies.

No one has ever recorded being sad without the body.

The spirit of man is the man.

It would not be accurate to say the 1/3rd of the man is spirit.

Man is like an iceberg in that the greatest part of him is unseen.

When a man goes to heaven it would not be accurate to say that just a part of him went.

Man is a spirit that has a soul that is staying in a body.

II Cor. 5:1-6

What does the spirit look like ?

The spirit is not a mist or vapor.

When we get to heaven we will be able to recognize each other.

If our spirits would all leave the bodies we would all be able to tell each other apart.

Where is the spirit located.

When Jesus used the words belly and Paul used the word heart they were not used in the physical terms.

If the belly is the real physical place that Jesus was talking about, then the larger your belly the more capacity one would have for the things of God.

We would then be able to recognize people in heaven by the size of there stomach.

We do not want to wait until we get to heaven until we become aware of the spirit of man.

How big is the spirit ?

Your spirit was the part of you that got born again so we must do something about the mind and the body.
